The Littleton Board of Selectmen is accepting nominations for the following positions:
Budget Committee – Three (3) three year terms.

The Budget Committee reviews the preliminary budget and presents to the Select Board the committee's recommendations as to any modifications thereto.

Opera House Management Commission – One (1) three year term.

The Commission will establish policy for the use of the Opera House performance venue portion of the Town Building; establish a procedure to account for expenses and revenues; assess what it will cost to renovate, repair, maintain and operate the Opera House.

Conservation Commission – One (1) three year terms and one (1) three year term Alternate position.

The commission oversees the proper utilization and protection of watershed resources of the Town of Littleton. Duties of members are described as advisory, educational and includes the examination of dredge and fill permit applications, and the drawing up of a natural resource inventory.

Planning Board – Three (3) one year term.

The Planning Board has a variety of functions and duties including developing and updating the Town's Master Plan; working on a Town Capital Improvement Plan; adopting subdivision, and proposing zoning ordinances.

Zoning Board – Two (2) three year terms, one (1) three year term Alternate position.

The Zoning Board considers certain types of cases concerning the applicability of the Zoning Ordinance to particular parcels of land.

Water & Light Commission - One (1) three year term.

The Commissioners are authorized to fix rates for services and to establish reserve funds in the public's interest.

River District Redevelopment Commission – Three (3) three year terms.

Land Use/Development, River Resources/Landscaping, Special Projects/Events.
