Sealed proposals for the Littleton 21192/X-A-002(133), Mildred C. Lakeway School, Safe Routes to School Project will be received by the Littleton Town Manager ("The OWNER"), at the Town Offices, 125 Main Street, Suite 200, Littleton, NH 03561, until **2:00 p.m. (local time), March 30, 2017** and then at said office publicly read aloud. Bids received after the specified time will not be accepted. No late bids and no telephone bids will be accepted. All bids must be made on the bid forms supplied, and the bid forms must be fully completed when submitted. This project is Federally funded through NHDOT's Safe Routes to School Program (Federal wage rates apply).

Base Bid – The Base Bid work involves construction of granite curb and sidewalk along both sides of Union Street (NH Route 116), between Bishop Street and the Mildred C. Lakeway School, a total length of approximately 350 feet, and construction of granite curb and sidewalk along the west side of Pleasant Street, between Oak Hill Avenue and Pine Street, a total length of approximately 1,400 feet. In addition, the Base Bid will also include the reconstruction of the pedestrian access to the main (east) entrance of the school. Major items of work include excavation, drainage, gravels, curbing, sidewalk, Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) installation, path lighting, retaining walls, landscaping, signs, and pavement markings.

Add-Alternate A - Add Alternate A involves construction of an accessible pedestrian ramp and steps adjacent to the school annex.

Bidders will be required to furnish a bid bond in the amount of 10% of the total bid, and the successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price.

All individuals, firms, partnerships, or corporations intending to bid must be prequalified with the New Hampshire Department of Transportation for Road Construction and/or Site Work. Prequalification must be established no less than three days prior to the bid date.
